Dear Parents/Carers,

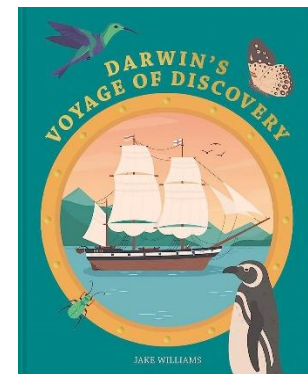
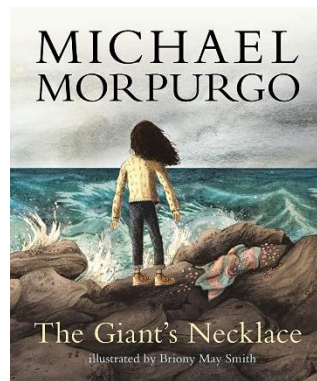
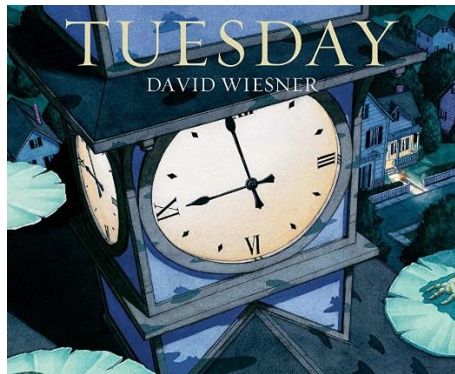

### English and Reading:

### Maths:

With this being our last half term at Elmwood Junior School, we have made our Maths lessons more about real world situations.
