
Welcome to Year 3 - Autumn 1








In English and Reading our focus books will be:





In Maths, the children will be learning about:

- Place Value adding and subtracting 1, 10 and 100 to a 2-digit number, moving on to 3-digit numbers when they are confident.
- Time analogue and digital
- Addition and subtraction using number bonds to add 2-digit numbers, rounding numbers to nearest 10 and 100.
- 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Finding a fraction of a set of objects (3/4 of 12 is 9)
- Recognise 3D shapes and identify properties of 2D shapes
